Weaving your way through history: The Cloth maker Museum Bramsche

The presentation the wool production in the early 20th, on the working machinery of that time century is unique. On the historical machines you will see the making of classical wool products of the Bramsche wool industry that later, can be purchased in the Museum Shop. The machines, dating from 1890 until 1925, are presented and explained, with love for the technique, from the Museum technicians.

On the tour you will see all of the 18 steps that are necessary for the making of wool cloth. You will be shown how the wool makers workers in 19th century in Bramsche. The rare machines from the early 19th century are a very special attraction. For the specialist, a treasure, for the layman a reason to wonder.

In an entertaining and playful way the visitor can learn about the people who worked the machines, about the raw materials, and about the changes in the textile industry.

Documentation with spinning simulator, models, videos, machines demonstration and computer animation opens up the world of the hand workers, the industry and the raw materials. The museum also has a restaurant, beer garden, playground, Museum shop, reading areas and rest areas. Also a pleasant walk over the Hasedeich, which also offers information about the usage of watercraft.

The Tuchmacher Museum Bramsche (Cloth maker Museum) is attractive and informative, and a popular excursion in the region of Osnabrück.
